## What's New for the 2020 Reporting Year

## **Changes and Notifications**

- 1. Three new parameters related to Particulate Matter have been added for RY2020. Existing parameters have been re-named to specify that they represent Primary PM (filterable + condensable)
  - a. Where appropriate, filterable and condensable PM emissions must be reported rather than primary PM (filterable + condensable). See the <u>EPA Particulate Matter Emissions Summary Sheet</u> for more details.
  - b. Bringing forward from a previous inventory will update to re-named parameter names.
  - c. New Pollutants
    - i. Particulate matter Filterable (10 microns or less)
    - ii. Particulate matter Filterable (2.5 microns or less)
    - iii. Particulate matter Condensable
  - d. Existing Pollutants Renamed
    - i. Particulate matter Primary (10 microns or less) (PM10)
    - ii. Particulate matter Primary (2.5 microns or less) (PM2.5)
- 2. Check the DEQ website for status updates/outage notices. Notices do not appear at top of pages when logged into ERIC. https://deq.louisiana.gov/page/EmissionsInventory
- Updated AP-42 Sec. 7.1 for Tanks Per LAC 33:III.919.G, all 2020 inventories are required to use the new method that went into effect November 2019. https://www3.epa.gov/ttn/chief/ap42/ch07/final/c07s01.pdf
- 4. Reminder: EPA is reviewing and sending compliance letters based on ERIC data. Please review your permit conditions and ensure your ERIC report is complete and accurate.
  - a. Any piece of equipment with a subject item in TEMPO that has emissions should be in your inventory with the subject item identified.
  - b. Emissions types should be accurate to identify emissions above permit limits as "Unauthorized" or other applicable emission type.
- 5. Please pay special attention to warnings related to release point exit gas velocity and flow rate greater than 5% of each other. These validation warnings will be ERRORS in future years. Please start addressing them now. If there is a programmatic reason that the numbers cannot calculate out properly, please let us know as soon as possible.
