Chapter 1. General Provisions

§102. Definitions and Abbreviations

As used in these regulations, these terms have the definitions set forth below. Additional definitions used only in a certain chapter may be found in that chapter.

Total Effective Dose Equivalent (TEDE)—the sum of the <u>effectivedeep</u> dose equivalent for external exposures and the committed effective dose equivalent for internal exposures.
