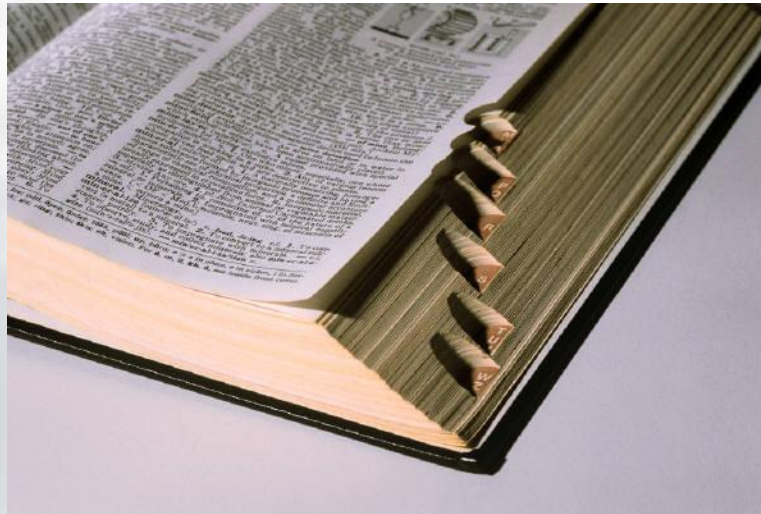

# Sewage Sludge -

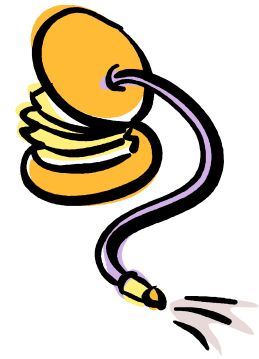
(Includes Domestic Septage & Portable Toilet Waste)

*Sewage Sludge* - any solid, semisolid, or liquid residue removed during the treatment of municipal waste water or domestic sewage. *Sewage sludge* includes, but is not limited to, solids removed during primary, secondary, or advanced waste water treatment, scum, domestic septage, portable toilet pumpings, type III marine sanitation device pumpings (33 CFR Part 159), and sewage sludge products. *Sewage sludge* does not include grit or screenings, or ash generated during the incineration of sewage sludge.

**Also includes *Grease Trap Waste* When Pumped or Removed from a *Food Service Establishment* and Mixed with *Sewage Sludge***



## Pumper of Sewage Sludge



***Pumper of Sewage Sludge***—a person who removes sludge from a sanitary wastewater treatment facility; domestic septage from a residential septic tank, mechanical treatment plant, or dump station for recreational vehicles and watercrafts or vessels; residuals from a portable toilet; or grease from a food service facility that is mixed with sewage sludge.



# Transporter of Sewage Sludge



***Transporter of Sewage Sludge***—a person who pumps or moves sewage sludge off-site by means of land-based vehicles, barges, ships, rails, pipelines, or other modes of transportation. For oxidation ponds/lagoons/surface impoundments, this includes the removal of the sewage sludge from the oxidation ponds/lagoons/surface impoundments to the levees surrounding the oxidation ponds/lagoons/surface impoundments.

## Sewage Sludge Transporter/Hauler Registration



**Registration – Registration Form obtained from the Office of Environmental Services or through the department’s website.**

**All the information required by the form shall be provided.**

**The registration period - July 1 to June 30.**

**All registrations shall expire on June 30 of each year.**

**The fee for registration shall be an annual fee of \$100.**

**To continue the operation of transporting sewage sludge – Apply for re-registration to the Office of Environmental Services at least 60 days prior to June 30 of each year.**

**[\*NOTE: All presently registered haulers will have to re-register (Submit registration forms to LDEQ) in April 2010.]**

## Sewage Sludge Transporter/Hauler Registration



- 1. The Office of Environmental Services shall be notified prior to any modification to the information submitted for registration, including, but not limited to, the following:**
- 2. The removal and/or addition of information about the facility to which the sewage sludge is being transported.**
- 3. The removal and/or addition of a vehicle that will be utilized for the transporting of sewage sludge.**



## Sewage Sludge Transporter/Hauler Registration

1. All transporters of sewage sludge and/or grease mixed with sewage sludge shall transport the sewage sludge and/or grease mixed with sewage sludge only to a facility permitted to receive sewage sludge.
  
2. All transporters of sewage sludge and/or grease mixed with sewage sludge shall maintain a daily log or record of activities containing the following information regarding the sewage sludge and/or grease mixed with sewage sludge:
  - a. The date the transported material was obtained, pumped, or removed;
  
  - b. The origin or source of the material;
  
  - c. The volume of material removed (generated) from each site,
  
  - d. The transfer and/or disposal site; and,
  
  - e. The amount of material that was transported or disposed.

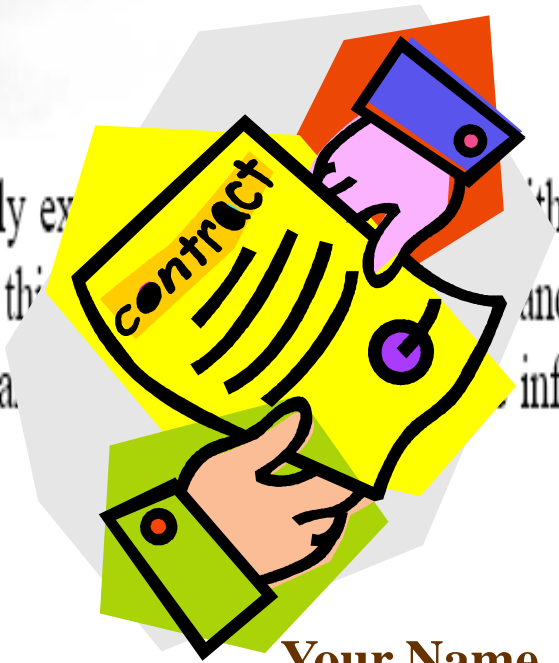

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## Standards Applicable to Vehicles Used to Transport Sewage Sludge

**When transporting sewage sludge, the bodies of vehicles must be covered at all times to prevent:**

- 1. rain from reaching the sewage sludge;**
- 2. inhibits access by disease vectors;**
- 3. prevents the sewage sludge from falling or blowing from the vehicle; and,**
- 4. minimizes escape of odors, and does not create a nuisance.**

**If transport liquefied sewage sludge - Vehicle shall be constructed and/or enclosed with an appropriate material that will completely prevent the leakage or spillage of the liquid.**



## Standards Applicable to Vehicles Used to Transport Sewage Sludge

**The exterior and interior of the body of a vehicle that is transporting sewage sludge shall be washed down, at a designated washdown area to:**

- 1. prevent accumulation of sewage sludge; and,**
- 2. for the prevention of odors and disease vector attraction.**

**The washdown area shall be designed, constructed, and operated to prevent groundwater contamination and stormwater run-on and runoff.**

**All water and leachate generated at the designated washdown area shall be contained and discharged in accordance with all applicable state and federal regulations.**





## **Standards for Sewage Sludge Pipelines and Containment Areas**

**Transfer points, pumping stations, and other facilities with a potential for spillage shall be located above grade, or in watertight compartments, and shall be in containment areas constructed to hold the maximum potential spill.**

**Containment areas shall consist of a base and dikes constructed of concrete, compacted clay, or other impervious materials. All joints must be sealed.**

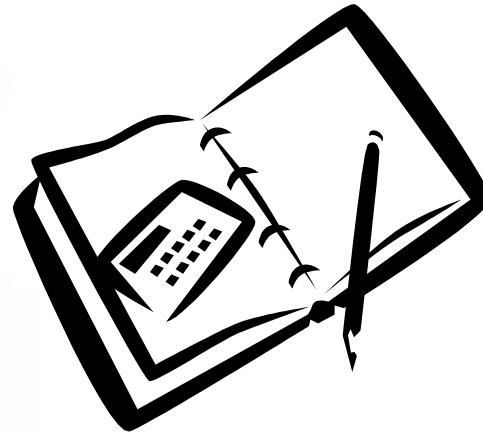
**Other Standards: The administrative authority may provide appropriate standards for transporters of sewage sludge that utilize other modes of transportation.**



**\*\*These regulations do not relieve the transporter from the responsibility of complying with other applicable regulations and licensing requirements, including, but not limited to, those of the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development, and with applicable ordinances governing types, sizes, and weights of vehicles used to transport sewage sludge on roads and streets that must be traveled during the transporting of the sewage sludge and with any other applicable requirements.**

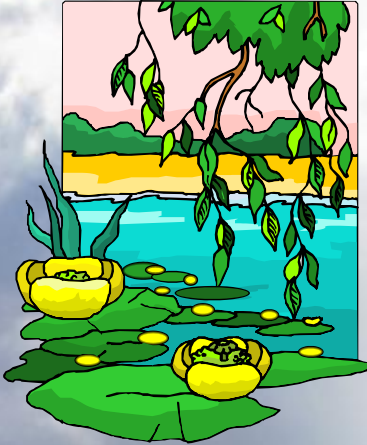
## **Allowable amount of hauled sewage sludge to be received at a Domestic Wastewater or Sewage Sludge Treatment Facility**

- 1. Any truck disposing of hauled sewage sludge into a Domestic Wastewater or Sewage Sludge Treatment Facility must be properly licensed by the State of Louisiana to haul sewage sludge. The receipt of hauled sewage sludge from an unauthorized/unlicensed hauler shall constitute a violation of the Domestic Wastewater or Sewage Sludge Treatment Facility's LPDES Permit .**
- 2. The introduction of any trucked or hauled pollutants is prohibited except at points designated by the Domestic Wastewater or Sewage Sludge Treatment Facility.**

## 3. Oxidation Ponds



- a. Treatment works utilizing oxidation ponds for treatment of domestic wastewater that receive hauled sewage sludge may not accept greater than 3% of the effluent flow in hauled sewage sludge daily, unless pretreatment of the hauled sewage sludge is provided.
- b. Treatment works utilizing oxidation ponds for treatment of domestic wastewater that do receive hauled sewage sludge will receive 10/15 or more stringent limits<sup>1</sup>. Coverage either under the Class IV Sanitary General permit or given an individual permit.

<sup>1</sup> Oxidation ponds that discharge directly into the Mississippi, Red or Atchafalaya Rivers may retain secondary limitations.

## 4. Other Treatment Technologies

Treatment works utilizing treatment technology other than oxidation ponds for treatment of domestic wastewater that receive hauled sewage sludge may not accept greater than 3% of the effluent flow in hauled sewage sludge daily, unless pretreatment of the hauled sewage sludge is provided.

## 5. Pretreatment Requirements

Pretreatment of hauled sewage sludge may be accomplished by equalization, direct discharge into the digester, or other accepted technology.

## **Use or Disposal Options in Louisiana are:**

- 1. Treatment of the Sewage Sludge into a Biosolids for Beneficial Use through Land Application as a Soil Conditioner and/or Crop Fertilizer**
- 2. Disposal in a Permitted Landfill**
- 3. Incineration**

**Alternate Option → Pumping Out and Hauling Off and/or Giving Away (NOTE: This does not include for “Land Application” Purposes)**



# Land Application



**Preparation/Treatment of Sewage Sludge into a Biosolids that can then be Beneficially Used (the use of Biosolids for the purpose of soil conditioning or crop or vegetative fertilization in a manner that does not pose a danger of adverse effects upon human health or the environment or cause any deterioration of land surfaces, soils, surface waters, or groundwater.)**



# Land Application



- **Preparation of Sewage Sludge into an Exceptional Quality Biosolids without/soil and site restrictions.**
- **Preparation and/or land application of a Class B Biosolids with soil and site restrictions.**
- **Both the Preparation of Exceptional Quality and the Land Application of a Class B Biosolids require permits for the Use or Disposal of Sewage Sludge and Biosolids.**
- **Restrictions on certain pollutants, pathogens, and vector attraction reduction for both Exceptional Quality Biosolids and for Class B Biosolids**



# Land Application



**Biosolids shall not be applied to the land until the site has been approved by the administrative authority that the land application site is a legitimate beneficial use site**

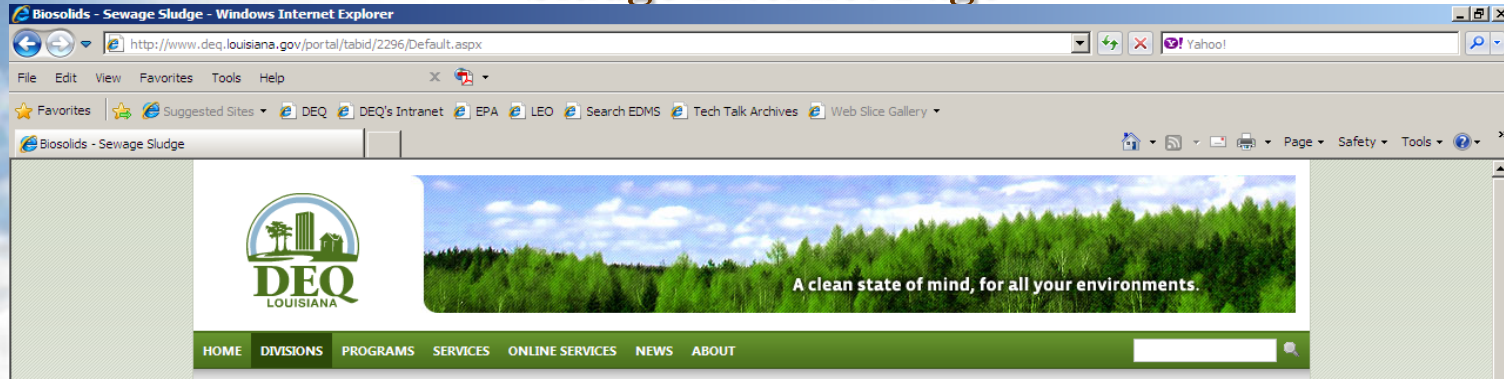
