

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Organizational Chart




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Office Organizational Chart




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Regional Office Map

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Regional Services & Efficiency

- To promote the Department's emphasis on increasing customer service, decreasing referral backlogs, improving turnaround time, and providing faster answers, the Office of Environmental Compliance will continue issuing Notice of Deficiency (NOD) and Notice of Corrected Deficiency (NOCD) letters from the Regional Offices for minor violations.
- To foster better working/living relationships between communities and industry, the Department will dedicate staff in each Regional Office to provide outreach opportunities and bring communities and industries together before problems develop.
- To enhance regional services, the Department will dedicate more staff from the Office of Environmental Assessment and Office of Environmental Services to more regional functional groups.



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Front-Loading: Community/Industry Outreach

- Working with LMA, LRWA, LPJA, and others to facilitate assistance for small businesses and municipalities


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Frontloading

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Green Government Executive Order

- Set energy efficiency goals for state facilities, office buildings or complexes for fiscal years 2009, 2010 and 2011
- Establish programs for energy analysis of state-owned buildings and identify opportunities for reduced energy use
- Adopt a program to reduce solid waste, including but not limited to adopting paperless office programs
- Review purchasing practices to assure 100% compliance with existing state requirements related to energy conservation
- Develop average fuel economy goals for the state automobile fleet
- Create an information campaign to disseminate to other departments for best methods and practices regarding energy efficiency and conservation.

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Storm Debris Management

Landfill and Debris Site oversight

- Began oversight of debris sites as established
- Daily oversight began in late May 2006 for 5 landfills
- C&D landfills continue to be monitored for unauthorized waste


