The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, has prepared a document that provides justification for the utilization of the Chef Menteur Construction and Demolition debris (C & D) Disposal Facility, operated by Waste Management of Louisiana, L.L.C., 29375 Woodside Drive, Walker, Louisiana 70785. **The facility is located at 16600 Chef Menteur Highway in New Orleans, Orleans Parish, approximately 2 miles east of Interstate 510 on U.S. Highway 90.**

Chef Menteur Disposal is a temporary C & D disposal facility authorized pursuant to the *State of Louisiana, Department of Environmental Quality, Declaration of Emergency and Administrative Order: Hurricane Katrina and its Aftermath*. The facility is an Enhanced C&D facility authorized to accept asbestos-containing waste material associated with the demolition of houses in Orleans and nearby parishes that were impacted by Hurricane Katrina.
