Each exceedance of the permit effluent limitations beginning May 13, 2008, is a violation of CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103, LPDES permit LAG570250 (Part I, Section B,

Schedule A and Part III, Section A.2), La. R. S. 30:2076 (A)(3), and LAC 33:IX.501.A.

The Respondent owns and/or operates a mechanical STP that serves the residences of Richmond IV Subdivision (AI# 104680), which is located at 36079 Lynchburg Drive in Denham Springs, Livingston Parish, Louisiana. The Respondent was granted coverage under LPDES General Permit LAG570000 on November 9, 2004, and was specifically assigned permit number LAG570252. LPDES permit LAG570252 expired on March 14, 2009. On or about May 20, 2009, the Department issued the Respondent a notification to reapply for coverage under LPDES General Permit LAG570000. The Respondent submitted a LPDES permit renewal application on or about June 5, 2009. The Respondent did not have a LPDES permit or any other authority to discharge until the reissuance of coverage under LPDES permit LAG570252. On or about October 19, 2011, the Department reissued coverage under LPDES permit LAG570252 to the Respondent, and the permit will expire on April 30, 2014. Under the terms and conditions of LPDES permit LAG570252, the Respondent is authorized to discharge treated sanitary wastewater from the facility into local drainage, then into Beaver Creek, then into the Amite River, waters of the state.

A. The Respondent was issued CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103, on or about May 13, 2008. The relevant requirements of the Compliance Order were to: cease all unauthorized discharges from the facility and to take all steps necessary to meet and maintain compliance with LPDES permit LAG570252, including, but not limited to, submitting missing and/or incomplete DMRs and NCRs, achieving compliance with the permit limits, and to properly operate and maintain all facilities and treatment and/or collection systems; submit a comprehensive plan for the expeditious elimination and prevention of noncomplying discharges and the noted deficiencies; submit a list of the certified operators responsible for the operation and maintenance of the facilities; and submit a written report that included a detailed description of the circumstances surrounding the cited violations and actions taken to achieve compliance. A response to CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 was

- received by the Department on or about July 21, 2008. CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 is a final action of the Department and not subject to further review.
- B. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about August 24, 2011, and a subsequent file review conducted by the Department on or about July 20, 2012, revealed that the Respondent did cause and/or allow the unauthorized discharge of sanitary wastewater without an active LPDES permit or other authority to discharge. Specifically, LPDES permit LAG570252 expired on or about March 14, 2009, but the Respondent continued to discharge sanitary wastewater as evidenced by the Respondent's continued submittal of DMRs. The Respondent did not have a LPDES permit or any other authority to discharge until the reissuance of coverage under LPDES permit LAG570323 on or about October 19, 2011. The Department received the renewal application on or about June 5, 2009. The unauthorized discharge of wastewater from March 14, 2009, through October 19, 2011, is a violation of CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 and La. R.S. 30:2075.
- C. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about August 24, 2011, revealed deficiencies in the maintenance and/or operation of the STP. Specifically, there was a buildup of sludge in the chlorine contact chamber, and there was sludge and solids in the receiving stream. In addition, vegetation was growing over the aeration unit. The failure to properly operate and maintain the systems of treatment and control is a violation of CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103, La. R. S. 30:2076 (A)(3), and LAC 33:IX.2701.E.
- D. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about August 24, 2011, and a subsequent file review conducted by the Department on or about July 20, 2012, revealed the following effluent limitation exceedances as reported by the Respondent on the DMRs:

R. S. 30:2076 (A)(3), and LAC 33:IX.501.A.

The Respondent owns and/or operates a mechanical STP that serves the residences of Belle Terre Subdivision (AI# 87012), located at 37630 Rue de Lac in Watson, Livingston Parish, Louisiana. Sani-Tec, Inc. was granted coverage under LPDES General Permit LAG570000 on or about May 25, 2001, and was specifically assigned permit number LAG570199. The permit expired on September 30, 2002, and was administratively continued. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about August 18, 2003, revealed that the Respondent had taken over operational control of the Belle Terre Subdivision STP on or about February 2003. On or about February 16, 2004, the Department received a NPDES NOI to discharge sanitary wastewater from the Respondent to renew LPDES permit LAG570199. On or about March 26, 2004, the Department received correspondence dated December 11, 2003, from the Respondent, notifying of a change of ownership and requesting the automatic transfer of the LPDES permit LAG570199 from Sani-Tec, Inc. to the Respondent. LPDES permit LAG570199 was transferred to the Respondent, upon reissuance of coverage under LPDES permit LAG570199 on or about July 6, 2004, and the permit expired on March 14, 2009. On or about May 20, 2009, the Department issued the Respondent a notification to reapply for coverage under LPDES General Permit LAG570000. On or about June 5, 2009, a renewal application was submitted to the Department. The Respondent did not have a LPDES permit or any other authority to discharge until the

reissuance of coverage under LPDES permit LAG570199 on or about October 19, 2011. LPDES permit LAG570199 will expire on April 30, 2014. Under the terms and conditions of LPDES permit LAG570199, the Respondent is authorized to discharge sanitary wastewater from the facility into Beverly Creek, then into the Amite River, waters of the state.

- A. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about October 6, 2008, revealed that the Respondent had deficiencies in the operations and/or maintenance of the STP. Specifically, the inspection revealed that at plant B the skimmer was not operational at the time of the inspection and solids were present on the surface of the clarifier. The failure to properly operate and maintain the systems of treatment and control is a violation of LPDES permit LAG570199 (Part III, Sections A.2 and B.3), La. R.S. 30:2076(A)(3), and LAC 33:IX.2701.E.
- B. A file review conducted by the Department on or about July 20, 2012, revealed that the Respondent did cause and/or allow the unauthorized discharge of sanitary wastewater to waters of the state. Specifically, LPDES permit LAG570199 expired on or about March 14, 2009, but the Respondent continued to discharge sanitary wastewater as evidenced by the Respondent's continued submittal of DMRs. The Respondent did not have a LPDES permit or any other authority to discharge until the reissuance of coverage under LPDES permit LAG570199 on or about October 19, 2011. The Department received the renewal application on or about June 5, 2009. The unauthorized discharge of wastewater from March 14, 2009, through October 19, 2011, is a violation of La. R.S. 30:2075.
- C. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about October 6, 2008, and a subsequent file review conducted by the Department on or about July 20, 2012, revealed the following effluent limitation exceedances as reported by the Respondent on the DMRs:
