- A. The Respondent was issued CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103, on or about May 13, 2008. The relevant requirements of the Compliance Order were to: cease all unauthorized discharges from the facility and to take all steps necessary to meet and maintain compliance with LPDES permit LAG570323, including, but not limited to, submitting missing and/or incomplete DMRs and NCRs, achieving compliance with the permit limits, and to properly operate and maintain all facilities and treatment and/or collection systems; submit a comprehensive plan for the expeditious elimination and prevention of noncomplying discharges and the noted deficiencies; submit a list of the certified operators responsible for the operation and maintenance of the facilities; and submit a written report that included a detailed description of the circumstances surrounding the cited violations and actions taken to achieve compliance. A response to CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 was received by the Department on or about July 21, 2008. CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 is a final action of the Department and not subject to further review.
- B. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about October 19, 2011, and a subsequent file review conducted by the Department on or about July 20, 2012, revealed that the Respondent did cause and/or allow the unauthorized discharge of sanitary wastewater to waters of the state. Specifically, LPDES permit LAG570323 expired on or about March 14, 2009, but the Respondent continued to discharge sanitary wastewater as evidenced by the Respondent's continued submittal of DMRs. The Department received the renewal application on or about June 5, 2009. The

Respondent did not have a LPDES permit or any other authority to discharge until the reissuance of coverage under LPDES permit LAG570323 on or about October 19, 2011. The unauthorized discharge of wastewater from March 14, 2009, through October 19, 2011, is a violation of CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 and La. R.S. 30:2075.

- C. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about October 19, 2011, revealed that the Respondent had deficiencies in the operations and/or maintenance of the facility. Specifically, the inspection revealed that solids were present in the receiving stream at the time of the inspection due to hydraulic overloading in the treatment plant. The failure to properly operate and maintain the systems of treatment and control is a violation of CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103, LPDES permit LAG570323 (Part III, Sections A.2 and B.3.a), La. R. S. 30:2076 (A)(3), and LAC 33:IX.2701.E:

The Respondent submitted a LPDES permit renewal application on or about June 5, 2009. The Respondent did not have a LPDES permit or any other authority to discharge until the reissuance of coverage under LPDES permit LAG570319. On or about November 16, 2011, the Department reissued coverage under LPDES permit LAG570319 to the Respondent, and the permit will expire on April 30, 2014. Under the terms and conditions of LPDES permit LAG570319, the Respondent is authorized to discharge treated sanitary wastewater from the facility into local drainage, then into West Colyell Creek, waters of the state.

A. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about February 11, 2008, revealed deficiencies in the maintenance and/or operation of the STP. Specifically, a build up of solids was observed on the surface of all three clarifiers. There were solids present on top of the splitter box that needed proper disposal. The effluent was light brown in color and there was evidence of solids in the receiving stream. Effluent samples taken

- during the inspection revealed a TSS exceedance of 44 mg/L, and a BOD₅ exceedance of 87 mg/L. Permitted limits for TSS are 15 mg/L (monthly average) and 23 mg/L (weekly average) and BOD₅ permitted limits are 10 mg/L (monthly average) and 15 mg/L (weekly average). The relevant requirements of the Compliance Order were to: cease all unauthorized discharges from the facility and to take all steps necessary to meet and maintain compliance with LPDES permit LAG570319, including, but not limited to, submitting missing and/or incomplete DMRs and NCRs, achieving compliance with the permit limits, and to properly operate and maintain all facilities and treatment and/or collection systems; submit a comprehensive plan for the expeditious elimination and prevention of noncomplying discharges and the noted deficiencies; submit a list of the certified operators responsible for the operation and maintenance of the facilities; and submit a written report that included a detailed description of the circumstances surrounding the cited violations and actions taken to achieve compliance. A response to CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 was received by the Department on or about July 21, 2008. CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 is a final action of the Department and not subject to further review.
- C. A file review conducted by the Department on or about July 20, 2012, revealed that the Respondent did cause and/or allow the unauthorized discharge of sanitary wastewater to waters of the state. Specifically, LPDES permit LAG570319 expired on or about March 14, 2009, but the Respondent continued to discharge sanitary wastewater as evidenced by the Respondent's continued submittal of DMRs. The Department received the renewal application on or about June 5, 2009. The Respondent did not have a LPDES permit or any other authority to discharge until the reissuance of coverage under LPDES permit LAG570319 on or about November 16,

- 2011. The unauthorized discharge of wastewater from March 14, 2009 through November 16, 2011, is a violation of CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 and La. R.S. 30:2075.
- D. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about February 11, 2008, and a subsequent file review conducted by the Department on or about July 20, 2012, revealed the following effluent limitation exceedances as reported by the Respondent on the DMRs:

The Respondent did not have a LPDES permit or any other authority to discharge until the reissuance of coverage under LPDES permit LAG570329. The Respondent owns and/or operates two (2) mechanical STPs and a two-celled oxidation pond that serve the residences of Riverside Ridge Subdivision (AI# 126986), which is located off of La. Highway 444 on Riverside Road in Killian, Livingston Parish, Louisiana. On or about February 15, 2005, the Department received a NOI to discharge sanitary wastewater from the STP at Riverside Ridge Subdivision. On or about March 21, 2005, the Respondent was issued ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER WE-AO-05-0080, providing the Respondent with interim limits until a final LPDES permit was issued by the Department. On or about March 10, 2006, the Respondent was granted coverage under LPDES General Permit LAG540000 and was specifically assigned permit number LAG541393. The permit expired on February 29, 2008, and was administratively continued. On about June 1, 2008, the Department reissued coverage under LPDES permit LAG541393 to the Respondent, and the permit will expire on June 30, 2013. Under the terms and conditions of LPDES permit LAG541393, the Respondent is authorized to discharge sanitary wastewater from the facility into the Tickfaw River, then into Lake Maurepas, waters of the state.

A. The Respondent was issued CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103, on or about May 13, 2008. The relevant requirements of the Compliance Order were to: cease all unauthorized discharges from the facility and to take all steps necessary to meet and maintain compliance with LPDES permit LAG541393, including, but not limited to, submitting missing and/or incomplete DMRs and NCRs, achieving compliance with the permit limits, and to properly operate and maintain all facilities and treatment and/or collection systems; submit a comprehensive plan for the expeditious elimination and prevention of noncomplying discharges and the noted deficiencies; submit a list of the certified operators responsible for the operation and maintenance of the facilities; and submit a written report that included a detailed description of the circumstances surrounding the cited violations and actions taken to achieve compliance. A response to CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND

- NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 was received by the Department on or about July 21, 2008. CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103 is a final action of the Department and not subject to further review.
- B. An inspection conducted by the Department on or about January 24, 2008, in response to citizen's complaints, revealed deficiencies in the maintenance and/or operation of the STP. Specifically, the sewer treatment system was experiencing an overflowing manhole into local drainage at 28525 Ridge Lane during rain events, and blocked sewer lines at 28525 Ridge Lane and 28545 Ridge Lane. The sewer system had several breaks in the lines of the collection system. Each time a rainfall event occurred, the collection system filled up with water causing the manhole to overflow in front of the residence located at 28525 Ridge Lane. The failure to properly operate and maintain the systems of treatment and control is a violation of LPDES permit LAG543193 (Part I, Section B, and Part III, Sections A.2 and B.3.a), La. R. S. 30:2076 (A)(3), and LAC 33:IX.2701.E.
- C. A file review conducted by the Department on or about July 20, 2012, revealed that the Respondent did cause or allow the unauthorized discharges of untreated sewage. Specifically, on or about December 14, 2009, December 17, 2009, and December 30, 2009, the Respondent did cause or allow the discharges of approximately 1,000 gallons of untreated sewage from the sewer collection system on Ridge Lane in Riverside Ridge Subdivision due to overflows from a manhole and drain into the Tickfaw River. Each unauthorized discharge of untreated sewage is a violation of CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103, LPDES permit LAG541393 (Part III, Section A.2), La. R.S. 30:2076 (A)(3), LAC 33:IX.501.A and LAC 33:IX.501.C. The failure to properly operate and maintain the facility is a violation of CONSOLIDATED COMPLIANCE ORDER AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY WE-CN-08-0103, LPDES permit LAG541393 (Part III, Section A.2 and B.3.a), La. R.S. 30:2076 (A) (3), and LAC 33:IX.2701.E.
