Who must file the hazardous waste report?

- A site that met the definition of a RCRA Large Quantity Generator (LQG) during 2018 Or/and
- A site that treated, stored, recycled or disposed of RCRA hazardous wastes on-site or shipped hazardous waste off-site to a RCRA permitted treatment, storage, recycling and disposal facility or received hazardous wastes from off-site hazardous waste generators without storing the wastes before recycling during 2018

Definition of LQG

- Site that generates in any single calendar month ≥ 1000 kg of RCRA non-acute hazardous waste OR
- •Site that generates in any single calendar month or accumulates at any time > 1 kg of RCRA acute hazardous waste or

Definition of LQG (Cont.)

 Site that generates in any single calendar month or accumulates at any time > 100 kg of residue or contaminated soil, waste, or other debris resulting from the cleanup of a spill, into or on any land or water, of any RCRA acute hazardous waste. Acute hazardous waste is any hazardous waste with an EPA Hazardous Waste code starting with a "P" and Fo20, Fo21, Fo22, Fo23, Fo26, and Fo27. or

Definition of LQG (Cont.)

 Site that generates amounts above the LQG threshold of either acute hazardous waste or residue or contaminated soil containing acute hazardous waste would become a LQG for the calendar month. In this case you need to complete a Hazardous Waste Report.

What changes have been made to the hazardous waste report?

There are no reporting changes for Louisiana 2018 reporting year. However, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has updated the RCRA Subtitle C Reporting forms for hazardous waste reporting to include forms required by the New Generator Improvements Rule. The State of Louisiana has not adopted the hazardous waste generator improvements rule at this time. Sections 12-15 and 17 of the RCRA Subtitle C Site Identification Form and associated addendums are not applicable to Louisiana reporters at this time.



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










Generation and Management Form (GM Form)








Waste Received From Off-Site FORM (WR Form)






Off-Site Identification Form (OI Form)



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
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Reporting

Annual Hazardous Waste Reporting

All RCRA Large Quantity Generators (>1000 Kg / Mo) and permitted Treater, Storer, or Disposer (TSD) facilities must complete the 2018 Annual Hazardous Waste Report according to LAC 33:V. Small Quantity Generators and Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators are not required to file the Annual Hazardous Waste Report in accordance with LAC 33:V Chapters 1, 11, 15, 17-21, 23-29, and 31-33, 35, 37.

The Annual Hazardous Waste Report must be received by the March 1, 2019 reporting deadline.

The <u>EPA Hazardous Waste Report Instructions and Forms Booklet</u> provides information on completing your 2018 Hazardous Waste Report. Paper reporting forms may be found at the end of the instruction booklet. We do encourage the use of the <u>Easitrak</u> software to complete and submit your 2018 Annual Hazardous Waste Report. The State of Louisiana has not adopted the hazardous waste generator improvements rule at this time, however, the <u>EPA Instructions and Forms Booklet</u> includes forms to be completed by states that have adopted the rule. Sections 12-15 and 17 of the RCRA Subtitle C Site Identification Form do not apply to Louisiana reporters at this time.

HW Reporting Workshops

The <u>Workshop Schedule</u> lists the dates and times that the workshops will be held. The 2018 Annual Hazardous Waste Report must be received by LDEQ by March 1, 2019. The link to the Biennial Reportable & Non-Reportable Waste reference document is as follows: EPA Reporting. Workshops provide an excellent opportunity for representatives from LDEQ to address any questions or concerns that you may have regarding completion of the Annual Hazardous Waste Reports. Topics discussed at the workshop will include the reporting forms and use of the electronic reporting software.

The <u>Workshop presentation</u> may be of assistance in filling out your report. Please remember that the report encompasses all of your hazardous waste activity for 2018. Do not exclude any 2018 hazardous waste activities by submitting your report early. Your report should not be submitted until after January 1, 2019. The 2018 reporting year is a State reporting year. Reports should be submitted to Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ)
