Enviroshool webinar on Superfund Program to be held Oct. 15

BATON ROUGE – The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality is hosting an Enviroshool webinar tomorrow, Oct. 15 at 10:00 a.m. The webinar will provide an overview of the Superfund program and Superfund sites.

This webinar will answer questions such as: What exactly is a Superfund Site? What actions does the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) take under the Superfund Program? Why do some sites stay as “proposed” instead of being listed as Superfund? Are new Superfund Sites still being listed? What happens to a Superfund site after cleanup?

Those questions will be discussed, along with a description of the interaction between the Federal Superfund program and the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality. Participants will also learn why the Superfund has not been super-funded since 1990 and what this means for cleanup magnitude and duration.
