Persons operating within the State under provisions of LAC 33:XV.212 or 390 (Louisiana Radiation Regulations) shall submit the annual fee of the reciprocal recognition of the license for one year from date of receipt. **Notification is required at least three working or business days prior to engaging in such activity.**

Licensees must submit a complete copy of their radioactive material license, with amendments, operating and emergency procedures, and have in their possession a copy of the regulations and proper transportation documents prior to operating within the State.

A DRC-20 <u>must</u> be submitted for each **industrial radiographer** that works in Louisiana. **Two (2)** radiographers are **required** at each temporary jobsite. (N/A for gauges or analyzers)
